



PA28-181 Trial Instructional Flight (Piper Archer/Warrior/ Cessna 172M)

Cirrus SR20 G3 – Cirrus SR20 G6

The 60-minute trial instructional flight is the first lesson all Pilots undertake, on completion, the hour flight can be entered into your logbook as 1 hour of flight training and count toward your overall hours requirement.

1. On arrival, we will get you to complete some paperwork and you will then undertake a short ground brief in “the effects of controls”.
2. On completion of the ground component, you will go out to the aircraft with your Instructor and complete a pre-flight inspection of the aircraft.
3. Once in the aircraft, you will go through the pre-flight departure process.
4. Once the propellor begins to turn, your 60 minutes will begin.
5. You will taxi the aircraft to the holding area and await clearance from the Tower.
6. You will assist with the take-off and once in the air, you will be in full control of the aircraft under instruction.
7. You will assist with the landing.
8. This is the perfect time to ask your instructor questions regarding the courses and outcomes you would like.

You will be at the school for approximately 2-2 ½ hours.
